

Documents with Digital Certification

Until today, when you received a document with handwritten signature issued by AFITI-LICOF you trust in the validity of the signature.

The professional of AFITI-LICOF now have a digital signature with a certificate issued by CAMERFIRMA (authority of digital certification from Spanish Chambers of Commerce) that ensures that the holder of this digital certification belongs to our organization and is linked with it position.

At this moment you are receiving a document with digital signature issued by AFITI-LICOF. This document has the same legal validity that a document with handwritten signature.

Verification and validity of digital signature:

The necessary steps to verify the authenticity of our document are:

- ➔ Open the PDF document PDF (Acrobat Reader version 5.1. or higher).
Note: You do not have to take into account the initial warning messages (press ESC).
- ➔ Incorporation of the digital certification in your PC.
The digital certifications issued by CAMERFIRMA are hosting in the warehouse licence Microsoft Windows. If you wish to trust in the existing information in this store, and therefore trust on all digital certificates hosting in it, follow this instructions:

In Acrobat select <Edition>- <Preferences> <Safety> <Digital Signatures –Advance Preferences >, select tab <Integrate to Windows> and activate all the boxes of Security of certifications of Microsoft Windows.

Note: In the case that you want to incorporate the certification of the signatory in your list of reliable identities please contact with us trough the mail licof@afiti.com.

- ➔ The validity of signatures is:
 - verifying the identity of the signatory and
 - detecting the changes after its signing

In the tab/icon of signature “Signatures” (left side of your screen), with the right button of your mouse over the signature that you want to validity select “Validity signature”; will show the state of validation of that signature.

The validity of the documents issued by AFITI-LICOF is guaranteed if only appear some of these icons:
